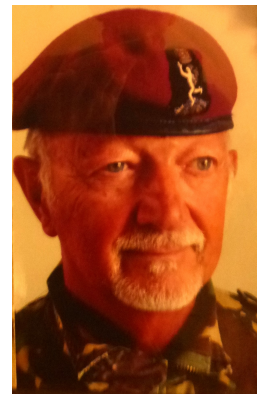


Lovat Scout WW1 Trenches



In 1915 a mock WW1 battlefield of around 15 acres was dug on Docking Common of which 3.5 acres still survives at Dreamy Hollow. It's thought that these trenches were dug as inverse defence position research and development trenches. A little more sophisticated than the training trenches dug by raw recruits (Kitchener's Men) up and down the U.K. Historic England have listed our site as one of national importance. Come and find out why these trenches are so special and the only ones known to be in existence. As a protected site access to the trenches is strictly by appointment only under the supervision of the warden or our guide.
